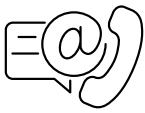

Being on the Church Electoral Roll – Why It Matters

If you consider this church your spiritual home, we warmly encourage you to join the Electoral Roll of our parish. Being on the Electoral Roll it is a meaningful way of saying “I belong here.”

Why is the Electoral Roll important?

- It shows commitment to the life of the church.
- Joining the Roll affirms that you see yourself as part of our worshipping community and want to share in its mission and ministry.
- It gives you a voice in church decisions.
- Those on the Electoral Roll are entitled to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), helping shape the future leadership and direction of our church.
- It helps with diocesan planning and support.
- A healthy, accurate Electoral Roll helps the wider Church of England understand and support the needs of our parish.
- It matters for good governance.
- The Roll ensures transparency, accountability, and fairness when electing PCC members and churchwardens.

Who can join?

Anyone who is baptised, over 16, and either:

- lives in the parish, or
- has worshipped here regularly for at least six months.

If you're not yet on the Electoral Roll, or you're not sure, please do speak to our Electoral Roll Officer, Sue Barry or Revd Tim Carter, or collect a form from the back of church or the Parish Centre.
